

Chambeau

Few designs are able to embolden you enough to say to a loved one when planning a visit, “Go ahead, bring the family!” And if she does, all will enjoy both privacy and communal areas reminiscent of an Adirondack-style lodge with a log-timber hybrid design. The Chambeau’s 3,004-square-foot layout, from Wisconsin Log Homes, is big enough to entertain yet sectioned off appropriately to be cozy. A nook-like dining area that adjoins a spacious kitchen—perfect for accommodating a crowd or hosting a cozy breakfast—cradles the great room. The main floor also offers a spacious bedroom and home office. The second level holds the master suite and guest bedroom. The master boasts its own private balcony to take in the views, a spa-like bath, fireplace and walk-in closet. Natural materials, including stone and cedar shakes, dress the home’s exterior and work wonderfully with the natural appeal of logs.
